Submit the completed STC application form –with indication Deck Officer or Engineer Officer- together with a copy of the candidate's Certificate of Competence (management level) and passport to: wettentoets@stc-r.nl.2. You will receive an invoice for the examination fee.3. On payment of the invoice, your request for examination will be sent to our foreign partners.4. You will then be able to make an appointment for the date and time of the exam and how to pay the local charges. <p>The addresses of our foreign partners are available at http://dutchlaw.stc-r.nl/ Please note: Our partners are closed on national holidays and official Dutch holidays.</p>		
Duration	The multiple choice exam on the computer will take approximately one hour. The candidate should use a copy of the English version of the "Summary of Statutory Regulations" for the exam.		
Examination fee	€ 240,- excluding VAT; Local charges for examination in Manilla, Jakarta or St. Petersburg, Kiev, Brisbane and Beijing, are € 150,-.		
Exam dates	All working days, with the exception of official Dutch holidays.		
Certification	Upon successful completion of the assessment a certificate "Wetgeving en Openbaar Gezag" will be issued by STC B.V. directly.		
Remarks	Candidates are requested to identify themselves by means of a valid passport.
