Targetgroup	The Yacht building industry is booming and along with it the demand for qualified personnel also. Evidence of successful completion of prior approved training courses may allow the mileage requirement to be reduced to 500 nautical miles;2. 2 days as watch leader/skipper3. 12 hours underway on watch at night.4. A current medical examination (only for professionals – STCW-BST) Candidates may sit the course prior to obtaining the minimum sea time. However, they will not be issued their Master of Yachts Coastal Certificate until all the requirements have been met.
Modules	The course modules are: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Theory and practical IYT Master of Yachts Coastal.2. STCW'95 Basic safety training (only for professionals).3. Restricted Radio Operator Certificate.

Examination	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The exam will be conducted by an independent IYT Master of Yachts examiner and takes the form of an oral and practical test onboard a yacht. Candidates must demonstrate that they have sufficient ability to handle, dock, and anchor the boat with a required level of confidence.2. Theory and practical exam.3. Theory and practical exam.
